Please note that this rider is only to be used as a guideline and that neither The Mighty Untouchables nor the PURCHASER are contractually restricted to the terms within. We reserve the right to modify the rider at any time.

PURCHASER agrees to provide The Mighty Untouchables with detailed directions to the place of performance, validated parking for band member's vehicles, and loading zone directions/procedures.

### **TRAVEL**

If venue distance is beyond 150 miles from San Diego, California, travel accommodations must be provided by the PURCHASER for The Mighty Untouchables. PURCHASER must provide airfare for a minimum of eight (8) people. If The Mighty Untouchables give advance notice to PURCHASER that the The Mighty Untouchables are arriving by air, PURCHASER shall, at his sole cost and expense, provide GROUND TRANSPORTATION for The Mighty Untouchables' eight (8) people, plus luggage and instruments, etc. between airport, hotel, concert, venue, and return to airport upon departure.

If air travel is required, PURCHASER must provide HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS. A minimum of eight (8) single rooms are required. The rooms shall be available until the day after the performance with The Mighty Untouchables to comply with checkout times and hotel rules. The PURCHASER shall not be responsible for any extra charges during the stay of the The Mighty Untouchables.

### **BAND DRESSING ROOM (or Green Room)**

PURCHASER shall provide one comfortable and private room. The room must be clean, shall contain at least eight chairs, and shall be within easy access to clean and private lavatories.

### **FOOD AND BEVERAGES**

Hot meal requested for 8 performers (1 vegetarian), 8 plates & silverware. Served or set at least 1 hr prior to performance, with non-perishable foods kept out as long as possible during performance. PURCHASER shall provide refreshments in quantities sufficient for eight (8) persons, available from bands arrival until departure. A case of 24 bottled waters must be supplied for the on-stage performance.

### **TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Sound Check: 2 hrs prior to event, (duration is 30 minutes - 1 hour)
- Required Space: 30' wide x 20' deep
- Stage/Riser: 20' wide x 16 deep' x 2' height
- Drum Riser: 8' x 8' x 2'
- If the venue is supplying a sound system -
- Stage Power: 4 separate 20 amp circuits
- Sound System: Mains/Subs Basic: EV, Mackie, JBL etc...
- Sound System power: Basic: 2 Crown power amps
- Mixing Board: Basic: Mackie 1604
- 2 Separate D.I.'s for keyboard
- Lighting: 2 separate light towers, 4 individual lights in each tower

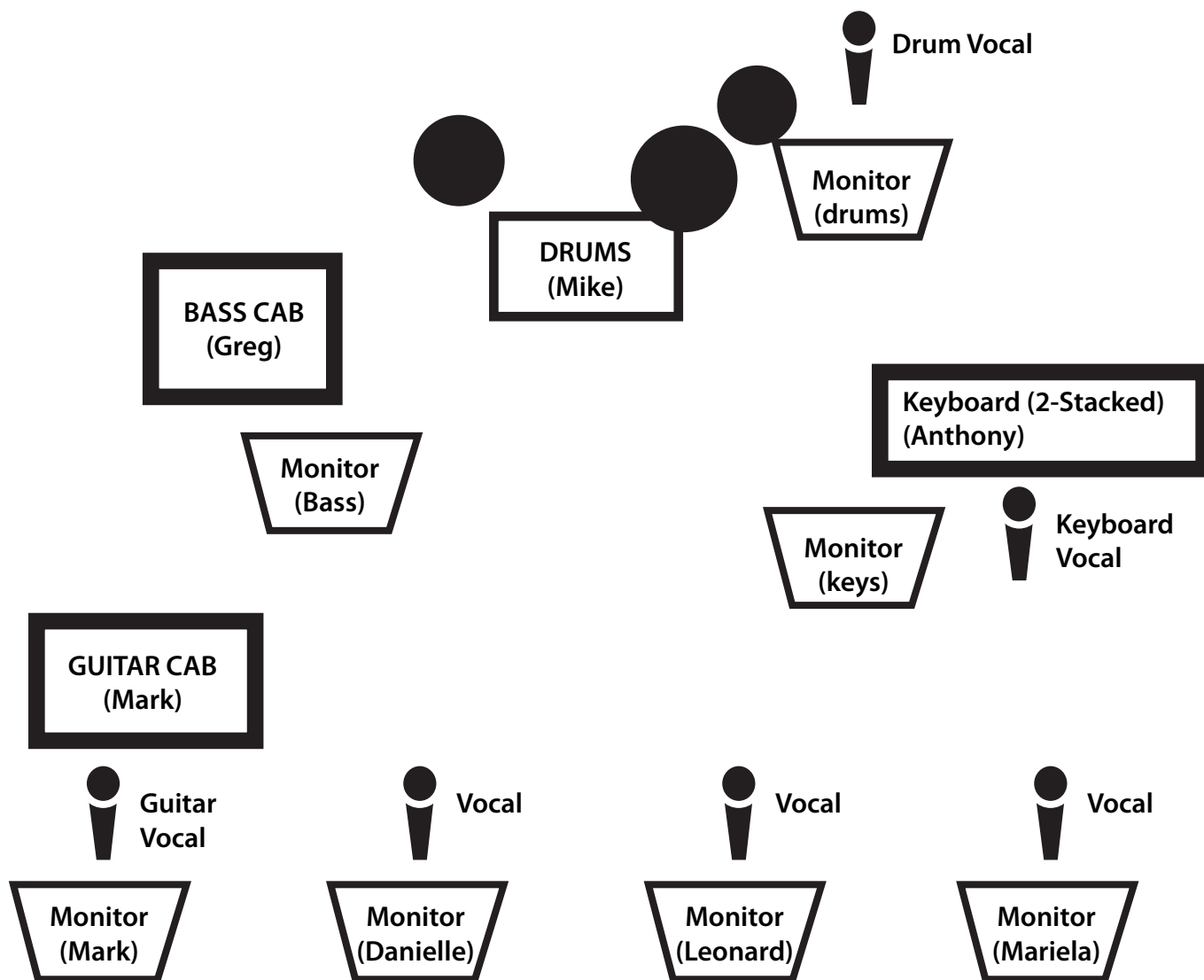

# OFFICIAL STAGE PLOT

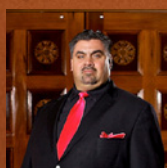

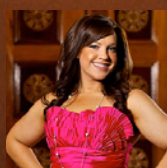
**Mike Holguin – Co-Leader/Musical Director/Drums/Vocals:**

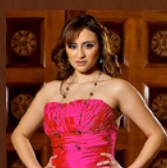
**Leonard Tucker – Vocals:**

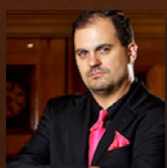
**Danielle Tucker – Vocals:**

Danielle's powerfully rich voice makes a big country sound that comes from deep down in her soul. Her musical career is on a major role of late and showing no signs of slowing down. Last year she won the "Oceanside Idol" singing competition sponsored by KSON, which earned her a trip to see the ACM Awards in Las Vegas. This year, accompanied by Mark Fulton and others, Danielle clinched the Viejas Big Country Show-down title – a mega-battle of twenty stellar bands sponsored by KSON and Viejas DreamCatcher. For this victory, she was awarded a \$10,000 cash prize and another trip to this year's ACM Awards in Las Vegas. Danielle has also opened for well-known country acts, including Keith Anderson, Carter's Chord, Chris Young, Jamey Johnson, and Ashton Shepherd.



**Mariela Contreras – Vocals:**

Mariela's talent was apparent early, just moments after birth in San Diego, her first cries for breath echoed with such mellifluous clarity that the attending doctors and nurses paused in reverence—they knew a star was born. By day a hardworking student at San Diego State University, at night this song bird has developed a respectable professional musical career with numerous commercial recordings and professional appearances to her name—most recently as the Spanish voice of the San Diego County Fair. You may have also heard her singing the National Anthem for the San Diego Padres. Mariela combines a classic beauty that harkens back to yester year with a truly soulful voice that will touch your heart and when el ritmo de la noche strikes you this bilingual bombshell brings the heat Latino style evoking memories of Selena, Celia Cruz, and Jennifer Lopez.



**Anthony Smith – Keyboard/Vocals:**

Anthony Smith, has been a highly sought-after pro for twenty-plus years. He has performed with countless artists and groups in numerous genres, including jazz, rock, R&B, blues, Latin, reggae, hip-hop, singer/songwriter, and others. Some of his groups included Koro Libre, La Vibra, Myriad, Giant People, Global Funk Council, Anthony Smith's Trunk Fulla Funk, and KD3. Smith has shared the stage with such greats as Hollis Gentry III, Mike Wofford, Don Menza, Bob Magnusson, Holly Hoffman, Paul Sundfor Brian Lynch, Fareed Haque, Ivan Neville, Jeff Coffin and Kofi Burbridge. While obtaining his Masters at San Diego State University, Smith served as Assistant Musical Director for the La Jolla Playhouse's production of "Xanadu" (fresh from Broadway).



**Greg Merrill – Bass Guitar:**

Greg is Southern California's most sought after bassist, having performed in over forty countries, and with the Royal Russian Orchestra and the San Diego Symphony. Also on his list of accomplishments are his performances at "The House of Blues," and you may have heard him on the radio in various commercial jingles. Greg earned an Associates of Arts degree in music and was awarded a full scholarship to Berkeley School of Music in Boston. But, let's not forget his patriotic service to the United States Navy, where he served as a member of the elite Navy Band and performed for prominent dignitaries. He has also appeared on the syndicated TV show Sabado Gigante and Siempre En Domingo, which aired to millions of people in Latin American. It goes without saying, the man knows his Salsa and Latin beats!
